Progress in the provision of technical assistance and capacity building support:

The Ministry of Trade in an effort to minimise delays at the border started developing border facilities to the OSBP status with the neighbouring countries. The Concept is aimed at reducing the number of stops and processes associated with cross border transactions to ease trade and movement of people. Six Borders - Mwanza/Zobue; Songwe/Kisumulu; Dedza/Colomue Mchinji/Mwami Chiponde/Mandimba; and Muloza/Quelimane were prioritized. One border of Mchinji/Mwami between Malawi and Zambia is operational from 7 December, 2022; Dedza was completed on 26 July, 2022, and Mwanza is at 90 per cent completion level. Songwe construction commenced in March, 2023.

However, inadequate resources to fully roll out the concept at the selected borders is the challenge.

Training for the border officials, support for ICT and furniture requirements and establishment other One Stop Border Post Projects.

The Ministry of Trade embarked on establishment of the Electronic Single Window system in the country. Feasibility study was completed in 2019 and implementation structures put in place in 2020. The project implementation is in progress amid tight budget.

Vendor to develop the National Single Window software has been procured.

Technical Assistance required:

Capacity building for officers operating the national single window and acquisition of infrastructure.
